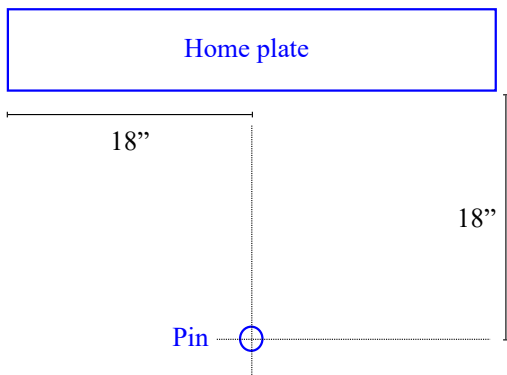


# Setting the Pin



The pin is a screwdriver set into the ground 18" behind home plate centered on home plate. Hold the end of the tape at the outside edge of home plate. Measure 18" to the center of home plate. Hold the 18" center mark and swing the end of the tape behind home plate using the center mark as a pivot point. Insert the screwdriver through the loop at the end of the tape and pound into the ground.

9 Foot line	23'	27'
Pitchers box	32'	36'
1st or 3rd base	48' 5"	53' 5"
Second base	68' 5"	75' 5"
Depth of pitchers box	7'	8'
